

## Monday Night Men's League

1. If you cannot make a Monday match, you may play the match in advance if it is agreed upon with your opponent. No matches may be played between 12 noon and 4pm Monday. \*A maximum of 2 matches can be played ahead for the season. Anyone exceeding the maximum # of 2 matches will be reviewed by the League President and Committee members and you may be dismissed from the League.  
\*Discussed and change adopted by League President and Committee winter of 2011-2012.
- 2a. If you need a sub, you are responsible for getting one. The sub list will be posted in the Pro Shop. If you do not get a sub, the League President and Committee members will review the circumstances and you may be dismissed from the League.
- 2b. During the regular season, call 3 names on the sub list in your handicap range. If you are unable to get a sub, call the Clubhouse.
- 2c. During the playoffs, you must obtain a sub from the golfers in your flight not participating in the playoffs that night.  
**The only exception to this rule is for Week 1 which is as follows:**  
**2c1: obtain sub within your flight from one of the 2 teams not in the playoffs.**  
**2c2: obtain sub within 1 flight above or below your flight from one of the teams not in the playoffs. Handicaps must be used when using this rule. Refer to rule 3.**  
**2c3: obtain sub from the regular sub list starting with those with a handicap as close as possible to yours. Handicaps must be used when using this rule. Refer to rule 3.**  
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**Start with rule 2c1 and work your way down to obtain a sub for week 1!**  
**\*Discussed and change adopted at Awards Dinner 2016.**
- 2d. \*During the regular season (excluding playoffs), League members can only have a sub a total of 2 times. Anyone exceeding the maximum # of 2 matches using a sub will be reviewed by the League President and Committee members and you may be dismissed from the League.  
\*Discussed and change adopted by League President and Committee winter of 2011-2012.
3. If a sub is needed, use 100% of the 9 hole handicap difference. If the 18 to 9 hole handicap determination ends with a decimal of .5 round up to a full integer.  
\*Discussed and change adopted at Awards Dinner 2014. (changed from 90% to 100%)
- 4a. Assignment of points. 1 point will be awarded for each hole won. 1/2 point is awarded to each player in case of ties.  
\*Discussed and change adopted by League President and committee winter of 2011-2012.
- 4b. 1 additional point is awarded to the player with the lower score at the end of the match.  
In the case of a tie, each player is awarded 1/2 additional point. All matches should equal a total of 10 points.
- 4c. **Effective with the 2017 League, 2 additional points will be awarded to the winning team. In case of a tie each team receives 1 point. This is a manual adjustment to be made on the scoring sheet once all points have been determined.**  
**\*Discussed and change adopted at Awards Dinner 2016.**
5. Subs receive points during the match as shown in #4 rule shown above. There is no penalty for obtaining a sub, although a handicap difference must be obtained following #3 rule shown above. Apply the handicap difference starting with the most difficult hole.  
\*Discussed and change adopted at Awards Dinner 2010.
- 6a. If your opponent does not show up or provide a sub, the player **may** play against par (**or opt for Rule 6b**) using his handicap determined as shown in rule #3 above. Points won are as shown in #4 rule shown above. Up to a total of 10 points can be won.  
The opposing team receives -0- points for this match.  
A "MINIMUM" of 5 and 1/2 points will be awarded regardless of the total points earned for playing the

complete 9 holes. Under no reasonable circumstances should a player be expected to play as a “single” The player must wait until the last group is on the tee and at that point join that group unless instructed by the Pro Shop to do otherwise. \*Discussed and change adopted at Awards Dinner 2012

- 6b. Effective with the 2013 League, the player has the option to play one complete hole and walk off the course and automatically receive 5 and 1/2 points. The score card should be left with the group he is playing with or turned in at the Club House to the team scoring that night. The League encourages all players to opt for Rule 6a above to enhance his statistics and to have the opportunity to obtain more points for his team. \*Discussed and change adopted at Awards Dinner 2012.
7. Repair your ball marks on the green and replace all your divots. You may also repair spike marks before putting.
8. Please wait until the foursome in front of you is on the 1st green before you tee off.
9. In order to keep a steady pace of play, wave up players on holes 7 & 9 at all times.
10. We play rain or shine; the only exception will be for THUNDERSTORMS or if the course is deemed unplayable by management.
11. Cards must be signed and scored by both players.
12. You may roll the ball over 6 inches no nearer the hole in your own fairway.
13. **A maximum of 8 strokes can be taken on par 4's and a max of 6 strokes on par 3's. Pick up is mandatory after max strokes are attained. This rule is intended to speed up pace of play.**  
**\*Discussed and change adopted at Awards Dinner 2016.**
14. In the event of a tie in the playoffs, the following shall apply: There will be a card off starting with the most difficult handicap hole. If still tied, continue to card off by the next most difficult handicap hole until a winner is determined. (all points attained with all flights matches used to determine results)
15. Rain/Thunderstorms  
Cancelled weeks will be made up at the conclusion of the regular season. If 80% (with the current 60 players in the League this means 48 players must have completed their match) of the matches have been completed, remaining scores will be determined by filling in the unplayed holes with the score (hole by hole) from the last time each of the unfinished golfers played in the League. If a sub is among the unfinished golfers the score from the regular player he subbed for will be used for the unfinished holes. The week will be then be considered complete.
16. A golfer must play 60% or more of the total regular season weeks to be eligible for prizes.
17. League members must have attained the age of 21 prior to the start of League play.  
\*Discussed and adopted as a new rule at Awards Dinner 2011.
18. Flight change will be limited (up or down) to 1 flight per year regardless of the average attained for any member of the League in the prior year.  
\*Discussed and adopted at Awards Dinner 2011.
19. The captain may move any player on his team (including himself) 1 flight. This change must be completed prior to the start of the second week of the regular season.  
\*Added to the written rules for the 2012 season.

20. The top 8 teams (based on total team points earned during the regular season) will make the playoffs with no teams receiving a bye. \*Discussed and adopted at Awards Dinner 2012.

Playoff schedule:

Week 1: Seed #1 vs Seed #8

Seed #2 vs Seed #7

Seed #3 vs Seed #6

Seed #4 vs Seed #5

Week 2: Highest remaining seed plays lowest remaining seed

Second highest remaining seed plays 3<sup>rd</sup> lowest remaining team

Week 3: Two winners from Week 2 playoff play for championship/ Two losers from Week 2 play for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.
